CODE OF CONDUCT

The Orange County Lawmen and Lawgirls organization pride themselves on discipline, dedication and sportsmanship. We have established a Code of Conduct that will be strictly enforced. This Code of Conduct will apply to all members of the organization.

1. All organization members are to act and behave in a way which aligns with the team's core values: Leadership, Integrity, Discipline, Commitment, Dedication, Hard Work and Volunteerism.
2. All organization members shall maintain an attitude of respect for the Board, Coaching Staff, other organization members, officials, fans and property while representing the organization both on and off the field at all times.
3. All organization members will follow the By-Laws and Standing Rules and Procedures of the Orange County Lawmen at all times. It is the responsibility of each organization member to know and follow the By-Laws & Standing Rules and Procedures. Ignorance is not an acceptable defense.
4. All organization members are responsible for notifying the *Director of Personnel* of any contact information changes.
5. All members of this organization will be free of illegal use of drugs and narcotics. A violation of this team rule may result in immediate and indefinite dismissal from the organization.
6. No organization member will attend a practice, game or charity event while under the influence of alcohol. You will be released from the organization immediately.
7. Any organization member ejected from a game will be suspended the next game and may be subject to additional penalties set forth by the By-Laws, Player Membership and Commitment agreement and any discipline taken be the NPSFL.
8. All organization members will notify the President of any type of lawful actions, unlawful actions, or any conduct that may be detrimental to the reputation and/or mission of the ORANGE COUNTY LAWMEN as soon as practical, on or off duty.

Remember, you represent the organization and Public Safety personnel in general. LEAD BY EXAMPLE. By signing below, you acknowledge the above Code of Conduct. If at any time, you do not abide by the above Code of Conduct, the Board will re-evaluate your position with this organization including up to suspension or dismissal from the organization.
